

~~Paper Towel Roll Bird Feeder~~

When our birds aren't in their barrel nest, they are hunting for food. Let's help feed them. Birds need to eat, too!

You will need ----

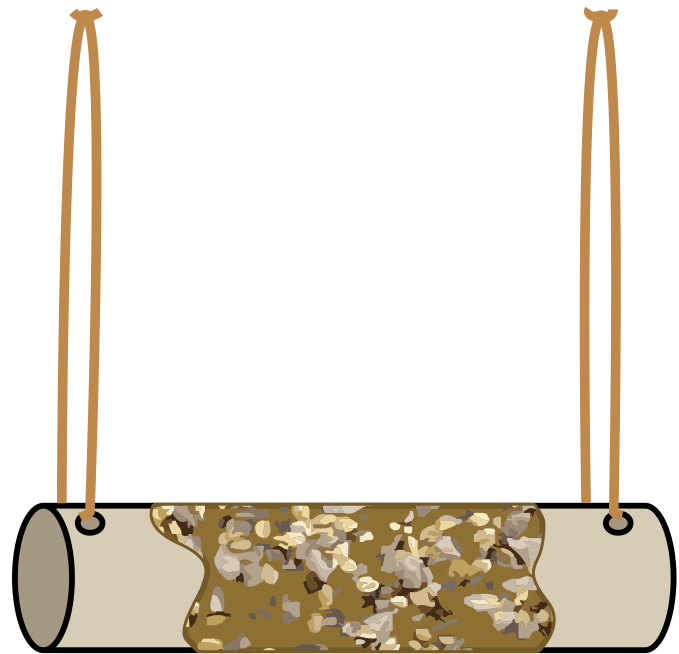
Empty Paper Towel Roll

Peanut Butter

Bird Seed

Yarn or heavy String

Scissors



Let's Get Started----

1. Cut two pieces of string or yarn. Make sure these two pieces are long enough—about 3 feet (or 1 yard) each.
2. Poke a couple of holes in each end of the paper towel roll so one piece of string will loop through one end of the paper roll tub and the other piece will loop through the other end.
3. Loop one piece of the string or yarn through the two holes on one end of the paper towel and tie the two ends of the string or yarn together.
4. Next loop the other piece of string or yarn through the other end of the paper towel roll and tie the two ends of the string or yarn together.
5. Hold the string or yarn on each end out of the way or tuck it in the end so it won't get messy.
6. Smear peanut butter in the center of the paper tube.
7. Roll it in bird seed.
8. TaDa—You're done!

You can hang your paper towel roll bird feeder by your back door or in a tree then watch the birds have lunch!
