



Looking for a tiger? You may want to go on a safari to find one and if you do go on a safari you would want to carry a safari net with you in case you wanted to catch that tiger. So, let's make a safari net. (Ask an adult to help you.) Here's how:

You will need ----

1. One plastic or string mesh bag (Oranges or potatoes often come in these bags.)
2. A pair of scissors. You will want to ask an adult to use the scissors. Do not use them yourself.
3. One empty paper towel roll
4. A package of long pipe cleaners or twist ties
5. Crayons or colored markers. Tiger colors like orange or yellow would be nice but you can use any color you like.
6. Tape
7. A good work space

Let's Get Started----

1. Begin this project by laying out all the pieces listed above in your selected work space.
2. Using the crayons or markers, "color" the empty paper towel roll
3. Cut off one end of the mesh bag leaving the other end closed.
4. Then thread the pipe cleaners along the top of the open bag to make a rim for your net.
5. When you have threaded the pipe cleaners all the way around the bag, twist the two pipe cleaner ends together.
6. Now cut two 1 ½ inch slits into the end of the paper towel roll across from each other. This will be the handle of your safari net.
7. Slide the mesh bag pipe cleaners into the slits.
8. Tape around the slits to hold the handle on the bag.
9. Now, you are ready to go on that safari.
