

Ladybugs are helpful and nice to look at. Ole' Joe Mather's biggest helper could have been a ladybug. Make a ladybug. (Ask an adult to help you.) Here's how . . .

You will need ----

- 1. A medium size pebble. (A medium size pebble will cover the palm of your hand.)
- Markers or waterpaint
 Red and black colors will work best.
- 3. Quick drying glue
- 4. Two googly eyes
- 5. Dishwashing soap
- 6. Some old towels to cover the work area

Let's Get Started----

- 1. Begin this project by washing the pebble in dishwashing soap and warm water. Rinse the pebble in Clean, warm water.
- 2. Lay out the towels in your work area. Place the pebble on the towels to dry.
- 3. Using the color markers or paint, paint the entire pebble red, then add black spots and maybe a smiley face.
- 4. Glue on googly eyes.
- 5. Let your ladbug dry on the towels to complete the project.
- 6. Now, you have a ladybug for your bug catcher.
